

Georgia ARES & Atlanta Metro Amateur Radio Nets Reference

Voice and digital nets, statewide through local club level. Each entry verified against the sponsoring club website where possible.

This document consolidates publicly listed amateur radio nets across Georgia ARES and the Atlanta metropolitan area. It covers the statewide GA ARES voice and digital nets, the Metro Atlanta ARES District Net, county-level ARES weekly nets, the SKYWARN program for the NWS Atlanta County Warning Area, other Georgia HF nets, and the regular weekly club nets in the metro.

How to read entries. Frequencies are in MHz unless noted. **(+)** standard positive offset, **(-)** standard negative offset. **PL** is the CTCSS tone in Hz required to access the repeater. All times are local Eastern unless UTC is given. **EST** in winter, **EDT** in summer. **LSB / USB** indicate sideband on HF. **FM** is the default for VHF/UHF.

Verification. Entries cite the sponsoring club or ARES group's own website where available. Entries marked **Unverified** could not be confirmed from a primary source at compile time and should be checked before you depend on them. The full source list is in section 7.

1. Statewide GA ARES Nets (Voice and Digital)

These are the section-level nets coordinated by Georgia ARES. The Sunday HF voice net is the primary statewide gathering. The Winlink and P2P nets exercise digital infrastructure that operates with or without internet.

Emergency Power Day. First Sunday of each month, members are encouraged to check into the section HF net using emergency power to validate their backup capability.

P2P quick reference. Address message to KX4MAT, subject <callsign>, <name>, <county>, P2P. Change Send As to Peer-to-Peer Message before posting to outbox. Use a Vara HF P2P session, not a regular Winlink session. Listen before clicking START.

2. Metro Atlanta ARES District Net

The Metro Atlanta ARES District operates a once-monthly VHF net that ties the metro counties together on linked repeaters. All metro ARES members are encouraged to check in when their county is called.

Practical Notes

- **Verify before you depend on it.** Repeater PL tones and net schedules drift. Confirm with the sponsoring club before an operational deployment.
- **Sunday at 22:00 UTC is the anchor.** The GA ARES section HF voice net on 3.975 LSB is the single most consistent statewide gathering. Most county groups encourage their members to also check in there.
- **First Sunday is the metro tie-in.** The Metro Atlanta ARES District Net at 4:00 PM and Emergency Power Day on 3.975 both fall on the first Sunday.

- **Digital readiness.** The GAARES-NET Winlink net (Sundays) and the KX4MAT P2P net are the section's regular digital exercises. P2P does not depend on internet, which makes it the most useful drill for a wide-area outage.
- **SKYWARN is event-driven.** Monitor 444.675 (+) PL 77.0 (Tyrone hub) or any linked repeater when watches/warnings are issued for the NWS Atlanta CWA. Direct phone to NWS at 866-763-4466 also works.
- **Cherokee ARES uses an unusual repeater configuration.** WA4EOC is on 145.190 with a +2.26 MHz duplex split, Tx tone 173.8, Rx tone 107.2. Program carefully.
- **EchoLink for travel.** W4DOC-R, KI4NGD-R, KK4GQ-R, KI4LMA-L, N4GA-L, KJ4KPY-R, W4BOC-R let you monitor major metro nets when you are away from home RF.
- **Unverified entries.** Cobb, Newton, Rockdale, Carroll, and Douglas county ARES groups did not have publicly published current weekly net schedules at compile time. Confirm with the EC before assuming. Their primary repeaters are listed.
